PAINTING FOR PEACE

I'm one of about 20 selected artists who have made a work of art for the "Painting for Peace" project. This is an interesting initiative by Jeanette Ohlsson at Kulturlänk in Sweden. The work, made of etched and patinated copper, is going to be auctioned off after it's been exhibited in a number of places, the first of which will be in Malmö this fall.



SOLO EXHIBITION AT ILLUMS BOLIGHUS IN COPENHAGEN

Six years after my first exhibition at Illums Bolighus on Strøget in central Copenhagen, I've returned with another exhibition! The same as last time, it's on the 2nd floor where the designer furniture is. I'm showing my very latest works, which I've been working hard on – when I haven't been doing big commissioned works, or been stuck under Icelandic ash clouds – since my last solo exhibition more than a year ago. There are several new oil paintings on patinated copper or brass, such as the sleeping "Isabella, Without Wings". A detail of that work is shown below.

There are also two works I've made using a brand new technique: giclée prints on metal. These technically advanced prints have been combined with etched and patinated copper and brass on beautiful backdrops made of black mdf which has been waxed by hand to resemble granite.

Another new type of works, also shown for the first time at this exhibition, are silkscreen prints on patinated copper and brass.

And on Illum's largest wall I have a giant banner, 5x5 meters, shown here on the top right.

Illums Bolighus is open every day during the exhibition:

Monday–Friday: 10am–7pm

Saturday: 10am–5pm

Sunday: 12–5pm
